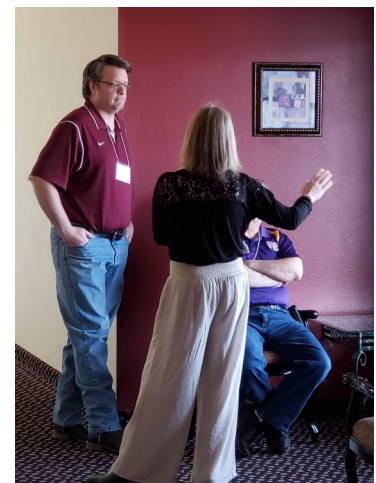
The date for next year's meeting will be announced in the future. We hope you can join us.
