You can help keep our gas system safe for everyone by following these gas safety tips...

- Help us protect our gas delivery system. Before you dig or excavate, call JULIE at 1-800-892-0123. They will help you dig safely by identifying the location of buried utility lines.
- Natural gas is treated with chemicals to give it a distinctive "rotten egg" odor. If you smell this odor, or think you might have a leak, leave the area IMMEDIATELY! From a nearby building, call the utility department at 333-3333, or dial 9-1-1.
