KNOW WHAT'S BELOW BEFORE YOU START DIGGING

You may be surprised by what's buried underground. That's because most electric, gas, water, sewer, and telecommunications companies are delivering utility services underground. Across the country, every nine minutes an underground utility is damaged because someone decided to dig without contacting the 811 notification center first.

WHAT IS 811?

811 IS THE NATIONAL CALL-BEFORE-YOU-DIG PHONE NUMBER. Anyone who plans to dig should call 811 or go to their state 811 center's website a few business days before digging to request that the approximate location of buried utilities be marked with paint or flags so that you don't unintentionally dig into an underground utility line.


